

**The Attributes of God**  
**Attribute #3**

1. Monotheistic – There is only one God, the God of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob; the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

A. Old Testament concept of God

D. Asserted by:

1. God himself. Isaiah 44:6,8; 45:18,21.

5. Apostles. 1 Cor. 8:4,6; Eph 4:6; 1Tim. 2:5.

E. Consistent with the deity of Christ and of the Holy Spirit.

1. John 10:30; John 14:9-11.
2. 1 John 5:7

F. Exhibited in:

- a. His greatness and wonderful works – 2 Sam. 7:22; Psalm 86:10.
- b. His works of creation and providence - Isa 44:24; 45:5-8
- c. His being alone possessed of foreknowledge – Isaiah 46:9-11.
- d. His exercise of uncontrolled sovereignty - Deut. 32:39.
- e. His being the sole object of worship in heaven and earth. Ne 9:6; Mt 4:10.
- f. His being alone good - Matt .19:17.
- g. His being the only Savior - Isaiah 45:21,22.
- h. His being the only source of pardon - Micah 7:18; Mark 2:7.
  
- i. His unparalleled election and care of his people. Deut. 4:32-35.

## II. Implications of there being only one God

- A. The knowledge of One God is necessary to eternal life – John 17: 3
- B. All saints are to acknowledge the One God in worshipping him – 2 Sam. 7:22; 2 Kings 19:15; 1Chron. 17:20.
- C. All should know and acknowledge the One God - De 4:35; Ps 83:18.
- D. May be acknowledged without saving faith. James 2: 19-20.
- E. A ground for obeying him exclusively – Deut. 4:39,40.
- F. A ground for loving him supremely. Deut. 6:4,5; Mark 12: 29,30.
