    - 1. to those who tremble at His Word
    - 2. He will vindicate those who obey rather than follow the crowd - Isaiah 66:5
    - 3. His Word is the ground of our prayers - Psalm 33:22; 51:1
    - 4. His Word comforts us in our afflictions
    - 5. His Word permits us to evaluate pretended revelations - John 7:17
