- III. Characteristics of the children of the devil (v. 12-17)
  - A. Death, hatred, darkness
    - 1. Death (murder) v.12.
      - a. Cain developed worship of God on his own terms
      - b. There was no blood sacrifice
    - 2. Hatred v. 12-15
      - Only difference between hatred and murder is the act; don't murder because of the fear of consequences
      - b. It is the moral equivalent of murder Prov. 6:17; 1 Tim 1:9
    - 3. Darkness (indifference) v.16-17
      - a. The unconcern for others outside your own sphere
      - b. Luke 10 The Good Samaritan

- c. We are in debt to whomever needs what we have; must question one's salvation if they are uncaring
- IV. Characteristics of the children of God (v.18-24)
  - A. Light, love, life
    - 1. Light v.18
      - a. Little children (teknia = little born ones of God)
      - b. Transferred from darkness to light (Col. 1:13-14)
    - 2. Love v.19-22
      - a. Everything that has value in my life I will give to you
      - b. The blessings of loving
        - i. Assurance because of things we have done (v.19) our own conduct
        - ii. Answered prayer (v.21) no unconfessed sin (Psalm 66:7)
        - iii. Obedience to the Word (v.22) is what pleases Him; not meritorious but expressions of gratitude; example of Jesus (John 8:29)
    - 3. Life v. 23-24
      - a. Abiding feel at home with Him
      - b. Believe in Him
      - c. Love one another
      - d. Obey His commandments
