1. The Foundation of prayer: the Intercessions of the Spirit

- ✓ "When you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words." Matthew 6:7
- ✓ "The Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us ... ²⁷ And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God." Romans 8:26-27
- 2. Collect for Purity. 11th century, then 16th century. "Almighty God, unto whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of my heart ..."
 - ✓ 14th century English version. "God, unto whom alle hertes ben open, and unto whom alle wille spekith, and unto whom <u>no privé thing</u> is hid: I beseche thee so for to clense the entent of myn heart with the unspekable gift of thi grace that I may parfiteliche love thee, and worthilich preise thee. Amen."
 - ✓ "The LORD looks down from heaven;
 he sees all the children of man;
 - ¹⁴ from where he sits enthroned he looks out on all the inhabitants of the earth,
 - he who fashions the hearts of them all and observes all their deeds." Psalm 33:13-19
 - ✓ "The LORD said to Samuel, 'Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the LORD sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart.'" 1 Samuel 16:6-7

3. Confession of Sin. Psalm 51

- ✓ Personal culpability: "I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me." v. 3
 - "Against you, you only, have I sinned ..." v. 4
 - "Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity ..." v. 5
 - "... justified in your words and blameless in your judgment." v. 4
 - "You delight in truth in the inward being ... teach me wisdom in the secret heart." v. 6
- ✓ Consequences and the Necessity of Grace: "Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy ..." v. 1
 - "Purge me ... wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow." v.7
 - "Hide your face from my sins ..." v. 9
 - "Cast me not away ... and take not your Holy Spirit from me." v. 11

- ✓ "Salvation belongs to our God": Revelation 7:10.
 - "Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice." v. 8
 - "<u>Create</u> in me a clean heart ... <u>Renew</u> a right spirit within me ... <u>Restore</u> to me the joy of your salvation ... <u>Uphold</u> me with a willing spirit." v. 10, 12

4. Declaration of Forgiveness. Psalm 103

- ✓ The Lord's attributes:
 - "The LORD is merciful and gracious; slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love ..." v.8
 - "As high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him ..." v. 11
- ✓ The Lord's grace extends to and embraces sinners.
 - "He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us ..." v. 10
 - "As a father shows compassion to his children, so the LORD shows compassion ..." v. 13
 - "He knows our frame; he remembers that we are but dust ..." v. 14
 - "As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us." v 12
- **5. Prayer for the saints:** for those who have been regenerated, so that they might grow in grace and holiness.
 - ✓ Knowledge of God's will.
 - ✓ Christ-like living
 - ✓ Fruit bearing
 - ✓ Deeper knowledge of God's person
 - ✓ Strength to live your calling
 - ✓ A heart of gratitude for your inheritance
- **6. Prayer to desire the Lord:** for those who have not been regenerated and need the desire to seek Him.
 - ✓ "O Lord our God, grant ____ grace to desire You with ____ whole heart; that so desiring You, ____ may seek and find You ..."
 - ✓ "By grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast." **Ephesians 2:8**
- 7. Prayer before reading God's Word: IOUS

- **9. Benediction** from Hebrews 13:21-22. "May the God ... equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight ..."
 - ✓ "Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, ¹³ for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure." **Philippians 2:12-13.**
