

Message from Barry Rack, friend of Bruce Bickel.

In the early 1990's Bruce taught a Sunday School class at Mount Lebanon United Presbyterian Church called the "Welcome Class". It was one of several classes held on Sunday mornings and it was intended for new attendees of the church until they found a more permanent class.

Well, I think they should have renamed the class because many of us never wanted to go to any other class once we experienced Bruce's teaching.

My wife and I were fortunate to capture much of his teaching on cassette tape and a couple of years ago I converted them to digital and I now have them stored in the cloud.

I have 9 topics that Bruce taught on. They are:

1. Biblical Principles of Finance
2. Fearing God
3. Getting Guidance from the Guide
4. Inductive Bible Study
5. Living the Committed Christian Lifestyle
6. Priorities for Christian Living
7. The Formation and Function of the Church
8. The Ten Commandments
9. Theme of Redemption

This represents over 140 hours of Bruce's teachings and I am making this available to anyone who would like to continue learning from him.
