- 20. If God is for us, who can be against us?
- 21. Don't be an initiator, rather be an aggressive responder to what we see God doing.
- 22. Revival occurs inside the Church and spills outside to the world.
- 23. God cannot deny Himself and He can't deny truth.
- 24. As soon as you confess, God forgives.
- 25. Be in the world but not of it, like a ship was meant to be in the water but not water in the ship.
- 26. We are to think right, act right, feel right. The world feels, then acts, then thinks.
- 27. Cover the wrong with love, forgive and move on.
- 28. We are double-dipped sinners, by birth and by choice.
- 29. Best verse describing Christmas (Isaiah 40:5) "And the glory of the Lord will be revealed, and all mankind together will see it".
- 30. Forgiveness is for our benefit.
- 31. A gentle answer defuses wrath.
- 32. The parting of the Red Sea was the demonstration of God's power in the Old Testament; in the New Testament it is Christ's resurrection from the dead and the empty tomb.
- 33. He calls us to Himself and we are the means by which God will reveal His holiness.
- 34. Ministry is who you are, where you are.
- 35. Christ saves me, not because I invited Him.
- 36. The ministry of the Holy Spirit is (1) scripture promises repent and belief (2) affirmation of the Holy Spirit with you (3) increased righteousness.
- 37. It is not circumstances that direct me, it is how I respond.
- 38. Blessed means happy in spite of circumstances.
- 39. We live by faith, not by sight.
- 40. If we become like the world, we lose our credibility. It seems we are now "Christianity Lite", more taste, less filling.

- 41. Being the light of the world means people aren't going to look at us, rather we illuminate things He wants us to see and be like.
- 42. Do not do things to seek honor from man.
- 43. Discern, don't condemn.
- 44. You study the truth to find out what is false.
- 45. Don't judge people by their motives, judge them by their fruit.
- 46. Prayer is the secret to behavior.
- 47. God always works through a remnant.
- 48. It's about the quality of the soil, not the seed; He will use us to seed, water or harvest.
- 49. There will be an irrevocable coming judgment.
- 50. Spurgeon said "I cease to count heads because truth is generally a minority in our evil age".
- 51. Forgiveness is an attitude of the heart.
- 52. Mercy is the willingness to absorb or bear someone else's pain.
- 53. Man cannot blot out his own sin and we can't change our hearts.
- 54. We should give away what God has given us without expecting anything in return.
- 55. But God!
- 56. If you know, you go.
- 57. Forgiveness is not something that can be doled out or calculated.
- 58. Grace is sufficient at the time of application.
- 59. The more you know of God, the more you will be dissatisfied with yourself.
- 60. The difference from a student and a disciple is obedience.
- 61. He who overvalues himself, undervalues his Savior.
- 62. Jesus' business plan was (1) He did it, they watched (2) He did it, they helped (3) They did it, he helped (4) They did it, he watched.
- 63. Jesus taught in parables, but not to his disciples; he gave them understanding.
- 64. The world's system is persecute, curse, hate, hurt and wound; the kingdom's system is joy, bless, love, forgive and pray.
- 65. Money doesn't corrupt, ownership does, and the hearts attitude toward it.
- 66. Indifference to the Gospel is rejection. Most people today want what God gives but they don't want what He is.
- 67. Stewardship is managing your love response to God.
- 68. Pardon comes when self-sufficiency ends.
- 69. It's not mercy when you think you deserve it.
- 70. A believer in Christ is never a victim.
- 71. Our citizenship is in heaven.
- 72. Don't fix your eyes on the calamity, rather repent and fix yourself.
- 73. A good work is from the inside out and the three tests are (1) is it done for the glory of God, (2) is it consistent with scripture, and (3) does it have the right motive; otherwise the best we can do is a good/bad work.
- 74. We have a famine of truth today in the church, we have squandered the resources God gave us.
- 75. By grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone, revealed in the scripture alone, for the glory of God alone.

- 76. God gives us a trust fund.
- 77. It's better to be separated in truth than to be united in error.
- 78. Church work is great except for the people.
- 79. Character precedes conduct.
- 80. When Christ was on the cross, we were on his mind.
- 81. I'm a follower of Christ, not a Christian.
- 82. Christianity is defined by Christ, not by people.
- 83. Between God and us is mercy.
- 84. Comparison leads to despising.
- 85. Pride comes before the fall.
- 86. The key question is have I proclaimed the truth.
- 87. No sin is too great that God's mercy can't overtake it.
- 88. There is no works salvation.
- 89. It's not your conduct, it's the condition of your heart.
- 90. Everything has been prejudged.
- 91. Repent and believe! These are commands, not requests.
- 92. Love is obedience, not tolerance.
- 93. You "may" but no one "can" unless you are drawn by the Holy Spirit.
- 94. God if you don't go before me, I know that nothing of eternal consequence will happen.
- 95. Check your pride and direct your devotion.
- 96. A life of subjection brings revelation and vice versa.
- 97. His love for us is bounty, our love for Him is duty.
- 98. It is the job of the Holy Spirit to point us to the person and work of Christ.
- 99. You must be, and then you will become, but the world says you become and then you will be. Ask yourself what have I been given to do, then finish it.
- 100. Unity is something to preserve, we don't create it.
- 101. God ordained, the Son accomplished, the Holy Spirit applies.
- 102. If we have saving faith, we are a love gift from the Father to the Son.
- 103. Power is when we are unified in truth.
- 104. We all have the same purpose, to demonstrate the purpose of life.
- 105. When did you come to saving faith? Three times (1) preordained, before the creation of time (2) Christ on the cross (3) when the Holy Spirit applies in our life.
- 106. There are 332 prophecies that are fulfilled at the cross and resurrection!
- 107. Don't suppose or sit in judgment of others.
- 108. Don't worry about what you don't know, just be obedient to what you do know.
- 109. God describes us as the "oak of righteousness" if we have saving faith.
- 110. A revival is a sovereign visitation of God in all His Holiness that produces increased righteousness.
- 111. The message is not about what God gives, it should be about who God is.
- 112. The four stages of saving faith, coming from the Holy Spirit, are conviction, confession, conversion and comfort.
- 113. We are "M8's" Mission Minded Members of a Movement Motivated by Mercy for Ministry in the Marketplace.

- 114. It takes the same power to save a soul as it does to create the world.
- 115. God does not send us out until we are equipped.
- 116. Evidence of faith and salvation can be found in the love of the word, love of people, love of Christ, and love of prayer.

- 127. WHJAD = what has Jesus already done.
- 128. There is no condemnation for those who are in Jesus Christ.
- 129. Jesus never motivates us to do something because of guilt.
- 130. The word Christian is only used three times in the Bible.
- 131. There is no condemnation and no separation because he is interceding for us.
- 132. The evidence of salvation (saving faith) is the prompt performance of those duties neglected. Every prayer is answered either through provision or protection.
- 133. Become God cognizant.
- 134. All our motivation in life should come from the mercies already received.
- 135. Worship is not an event, it is a lifestyle.
- 136. Don't build your life on preferences, build it on convictions.
- 137. Witnessing is not external, it's internal.
- 138. The chain of command = the Father ordains, the Son accomplishes, the Holy Spirit applies.
- 139. Comparison creates either pride or discouragement, both are bad, so don't do it.
- 140. We don't build the kingdom, we just reveal it.
- 141. The mission of the Church is purity through maturity.

- 160. Meekness is power under control. It means you have another option you choose not to exercise. Make your claim match your conduct.
- 161. Being humble, submissive, and obedient results in exultation.
- 162. Weakness is the common element in church leadership.
- 163. God works in us before he works through us.
- 164. We are totally inadequate but terribly excited.
- 165. Temptation = pride of life, lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes.
- 166. The Church today should teach Christ and Him crucified.
- 167. If you don't have it, you don't need it.
- 168. What am I going to do about what I just learned?
- 169. I'm a spiritual beggar.
- 170. Gratitude is the motivation for ministry.

- 180. Wisdom is not the accumulation of knowledge, it's the application of it.
- 181. The truth sets people free.
- 182. The moment we think we have merit, it is no longer mercy.
- 183. Why do I do what I do?
- 184. Grace is our currency, not money.
- 185. The more we give away mercy, the more we will receive.
- 186. Grace is what alters our relationships.
- 187. Everything in our life is determined by how we view God.
- 188. God is able to save, support, subdue, sanctify, supply, secure, and satisfy.

 - A. If we claim to have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth.

B. If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. C. If we claim we have not sinned, we make Him out to be a liar and His word has no place in our lives.

D. The man who says I know Him, but does not do what He commands is a liar and the truth is not in him.

E. Whoever claims to live in Him must walk as Jesus did.

F. Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates his brother is still in the darkness.

G. If anyone says I love God, yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen.

- 208. Is a dead person dead or just very sick? The reformed position says that dead is dead!
- 209. God is absolutely sovereign and man is responsible.
- 210. Having been born of God is believing.
- 211. Life comes before belief.
- 212. Eternal life is not time, it is a person.
- 213. Satan takes a truth and modifies it so we are deceived.
- 214. The book of Revelation is the final glorious picture of what Christ is like.
- 215. Freedom is not circumstantial, it is internal.

- 387. Someone else's experience does not become our obligation and vice versa.
- 388. Three words describe the church through the years...remnant, persecution and warfare.
- 389. You can't be career motivated and Christ motivated at the same time.
- 390. Any act of obedience on our part does not gain us merit.
- 391. You do the best you can and trust Christ with the rest.
- 392. Lord what are you doing in my life?
- 393. You don't want to find out God's will for you, you want to find God's will in you.
- 394. Our confidence is directly related to our humility.
- 395. Elders talk about the spiritual condition of the flock.
- 396. Four things that can hinder a preacher....money, pride, unbridled ambition, and women (temptation).
- 397. You can't love unless you hate.
- 398. The cross is God's way of defending His holiness.
- 399. When did we become a Christian? From God's perspective: Before the creation when He foreknew and predestined. From Jesus perspective: On the cross when He shed His blood for our salvation. - 413. Without the proper message there is no power.
- 414. The lesson from the Book of Titus...do not forget your past, function in your present, focus on the future.
- 415. Evaluate your own spiritual maturity by your hunger for the preached word.
- 416. The highest level of worship is the preaching and the listening.
- 417. Leaders are qualified by the Holy Spirit, not appointed by us.
- 418. Did I proclaim the truth, was I obedient, if so we will be successful...that is our reward, but don't look for a response.
- 419. It's all about Him and not about us. Recognize the authority of God.
- 420. Repentance is taking sides with God against yourself.
- 421. Acts 7:55-56 is the only reference to Christ standing, not seated, at the right hand of God.
- 422. The role of the manager is to provide, protect, and promote. Bruce described his department as nobody works after 5, nobody takes work home, nobody works on Saturday and no one gossips.
- 423. If you believe, you have a sense of your own guilt and sinfulness, you have actual hatefulness of sin, you possess an understanding of God's mercy in your life, and you have a persistent endeavor to lead a holy life.
- 424. Let the word of God dwell in you richly.
- 425. Great leadership is asking the right questions.
- 426. It is the Holy Spirit that pursues us.
- 427. Love creates love, His love for us is bounty, our love for Him is duty.
- 428. Christianity is exclusive and compassionate.
- 429. He wants to put His life on display through us.
- 430. God is very jealous of His glory, His name and his people (sheep).
- 431. Security is the feeling of unconditional love.
- 432. Our obligation is to obey His revealed will, not His secret will.
