US TRIP RAISES AWARENESS

In November 2017, Rev. Pastor Almir Pehlić and Rev. Tom Smith travelled to America sharing the vision of Christ the King church about spreading the gospel, making disciples, training leaders and equipping the saints in central Croatia. Old and new friends heard about our challenges and opportunities. Graduate studies at Trinity School and RPTS were also investigated. Over 1,800 miles were driven in 11 days visiting people in Washington D.C., Lancaster, York, Aliquippa, Ambridge, Beaver Falls, Grove City and Pittsburgh. A return trip is being planned for May 28 - June 7, 2018.
