- I. Introduction Psalm 128:1 Rev.14:1
 - A. In dealing with the nature of the fear of God, the very first problem we face is the poverty of the English word "fear."
 - !. Old Testament Language
 - a. The Old Testament uses seventeen different Hebrew words and one Aramaic word to describe different kinds of "fear."
 - 1). Stand in awe Psalm 22:22-24; Psalm 33:8
 - 2) Tremble before Him Deuteronomy 2:25; 1 Samuel 31:3
 - 3) Be in dread of Him Psalm 89:7; Isaiah 8:13; Isaiah 29:23
 - Living in dread Deuteronomy 28:66; 2 Chronicles 29:20; Genesis 31:42, 53
 - 5) To be frightened of God Exodus 15:16; Exodus 23:27; Job 9:34
 - 6) The terror of God Daniel 6:26
 - 7) The fear of God Exodus 3:6; Psalm 119:120; Habakkuk 3:2; Psalm 33:8; Psalm 34:9; 86:11; 112:1; 119:63
 - 8) Terror and Fear Deuteronomy 9:19
 - 9) Worship with trembling Psalm 2:11
