1. Context

a. getting the people away from resting in the glorious temple they built and in their outward performance.

b. 4 expressions regarding outward show where there is a wicked life (v.3)

2. Qualifications of one for whom God has high regard

a. poor in spirit

b. contrite of heart

c. trembles at His Word

B. What is it to have a trembling heart?

1. Reverent thoughts of God's Word

2. Listens reverently when God's Word is read or preached

3. It dares not cavil (criticize, find fault) against God's Word

4. It views condemnation of God's Word to be a dreadful thing

5. It views the commands of God Word to be binding and submits to them

It receives reverently the promises of God's Word

 4. It sees God’s infinite justice in it
 5. It sees God’s infinite power in it

 7. It sees the glorious mysteries of God in it
 8. It sees efficacy and life in it
 9. It sees the basis for judgment in it
 10. It sees the searcher of human hearts in it
 11. It sees that which shall judge us at the last day
