

Fearing God - Lesson #8 – Scriptures

Habakkuk 3:16–17 (NIV84)

16 I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled. Yet I will wait patiently for the day of calamity to come on the nation invading us.

17 Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls,

Psalms 2:11 (NIV84) Serve the LORD with fear and rejoice with trembling.

Deuteronomy 33:2 (NIV84)

2 He said: “The LORD came from Sinai and dawned over them from Seir; he shone forth from Mount Paran. He came with myriads of holy ones from the south, from his mountain slopes.

Deuteronomy 33:3 (NIV84)

3 Surely it is you who love the people; all the holy ones are in your hand. At your feet they all bow down, and from you receive instruction,

Psalms 119:162 (NIV84) I rejoice in your promise like one who finds great spoil.

Daniel 10:11 (NIV84)

11 He said, “Daniel, you who are highly esteemed, consider carefully the words I am about to speak to you, and stand up, for I have now been sent to you.” And when he said this to me, I stood up trembling.

Acts 9:6 (NIV84) “Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.”

Isaiah 42:21 (NIV84) It pleased the LORD for the sake of his righteousness to make his law great and glorious.

John 20:29 (NIV84) Then Jesus told him, “Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.”

Psalms 29:1–9 (NIV84)

1 Ascribe to the LORD, O mighty ones, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.

2 Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.

3 The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD thunders over the mighty waters.

4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is majestic.

5 The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.

6 He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, Sirion like a young wild ox.

7 The voice of the LORD strikes with flashes of lightning.

8 The voice of the LORD shakes the desert; the LORD shakes the Desert of Kadesh.

9 The voice of the LORD twists the oaks and strips the forests bare. And in his temple all cry, “Glory!”

Joel 3:16 (NIV84)

16 The LORD will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem; the earth and the sky will tremble. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Israel.
