Fearing God - Lesson #14 – Scriptures

Colossians 3:22 (NIV84) Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything; and do it, not only when their eye is on you and to win their favor, but with sincerity of heart and reverence for the Lord.

Zechariah 7:5–6 (NIV84) "Ask all the people of the land and the priests, 'When you fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh months for the past seventy years, was it really for me that you fasted? **6** And when you were eating and drinking, were you not just feasting for yourselves?

1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV84) So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

John 1:47 (NIV84) When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here is a true Israelite, in whom there is nothing false."

1 Kings 18:3–4 (NIV84) and Ahab had summoned Obadiah, who was in charge of his palace. (Obadiah was a devout believer in the LORD. **4** While Jezebel was killing off the LORD's prophets, Obadiah had taken a hundred prophets and hidden them in two caves, fifty in each, and had supplied them with food and water.)

Acts 10:1–2 (NIV84) At Caesarea there was a man named Cornelius, a centurion in what was known as the Italian Regiment. 2 He and all his family were devout and God-fearing; he gave generously to those in need and prayed to God regularly.

Hebrews 5:7 (NIV84) During the days of Jesus' life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission.

Hebrews 11:8–10 (NIV84) By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. **9** By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. **10** For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.

Genesis 22:11–12 (NIV84) But the angel of the LORD called out to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. **12** "Do not lay a hand on the boy," he said. "Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son."

Romans 11:20 (NIV84) Granted. But they were broken off because of unbelief, and you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but be afraid.

Psalm 147:11 (NIV84) The LORD delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love.

Psalm 112:1 (NIV84) Praise the LORD. Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who finds great delight in his commands.

Isaiah 60:5 (NIV84) Then you will look and be radiant, your heart will throb and swell with joy; the wealth on the seas will be brought to you, to you the riches of the nations will come.

Isaiah 11:2 (NIV84) The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD—
