

## Fearing God - Lesson #17 – Scriptures

**Psalms 55:19 (NASB95)** God will hear and answer them— Even the one who sits enthroned from of old— Selah. With whom there is no change, And who do not fear God.

**Psalms 36:1 (NASB95)** Transgression speaks to the ungodly within his heart; There is no fear of God before his eyes.

**Romans 3:18 (NASB95)** “There is no fear of God before their eyes.”

**Romans 11:20–21 (NASB95)** Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. Do not be conceited, but fear; **21** for if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you, either.

**Psalms 138:6 (NASB95)** For though the LORD is exalted, Yet He regards the lowly, But the haughty He knows from afar.

**1 Peter 5:6 (NASB95)** Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time,

**Malachi 4:1–2 (NASB95)** “For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze,” says the LORD of hosts, “so that it will leave them neither root nor branch.” **2** “But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall.

**Exodus 18:21 (NASB95)** “Furthermore, you shall select out of all the people able men who fear God, men of truth, those who hate dishonest gain; and you shall place these over them as leaders of thousands, of hundreds, of fifties and of tens.

**Ephesians 5:5 (NASB95)** For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.

**Ezekiel 33:31 (NASB95)** “They come to you as people come, and sit before you as My people and hear your words, but they do not do them, for they do the lustful desires expressed by their mouth, and their heart goes after their gain.

**Psalms 10:3 (NASB95)** For the wicked boasts of his heart’s desire, And the greedy man curses and spurns the LORD.

**James 4:4 (NASB95)** You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

**Proverbs 23:35 (NASB95)** “They struck me, but I did not become ill; They beat me, but I did not know it. When shall I awake? I will seek another drink.”

**Jude 13 (NASB95)** wild waves of the sea, casting up their own shame like foam; wandering stars, for whom the black darkness has been reserved forever.

**Luke 21:34 (NASB95)** “Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap;

**Isaiah 57:11 (NASB95)** “Of whom were you worried and fearful When you lied, and did not remember Me Nor give Me a thought? Was I not silent even for a long time So you do not fear Me?”

**Revelation 21:27 (NASB95)** and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb’s book of life.

**Exodus 9:30 (NASB95)** “But as for you and your servants, I know that you do not yet fear the LORD God.”

**James 4:1–4 (NASB95)** What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members? **2** You lust and do not have; so you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. **3** You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures. **4** You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God?
