John 17:5 <sup>5</sup> And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

Matt. 5:14-16 <sup>14</sup> "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. <sup>16</sup> In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Ps. 119:105 <sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

John 8:12 <sup>12</sup> Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

Ex. 25:37 <sup>37</sup> You shall make seven lamps for it. And the lamps shall be set up so as to give light on the space in front of it.

Luke 1:78,79 <sup>78</sup> because of the tender mercy of our God, whereby the sunrise shall visit us from on high <sup>79</sup> to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

I John 1:5 <sup>5</sup> This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

Gen. 1:2-4 <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup> And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness.

Is. 9:2 <sup>2</sup> The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone.

Ex. 10:23 <sup>23</sup> They did not see one another, nor did anyone rise from his place for three days, but all the people of Israel had light where they lived.

2 Cor. 6:14 <sup>14</sup> Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness?

Matt. 16:18 <sup>18</sup> And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

I John 2:8 <sup>8</sup> At the same time, it is a new commandment that I am writing to you, which is true in him and in you, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining.
