Eph. 5:21,22 submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ. 22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Eph. 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her,

Eph. 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Eph. 6:5 Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, 6 not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, 7 rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, 8 knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. 9 Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.
